The AMT met on October 16, 2018. Present were the following Doug Greenburg, Jim Ingram, Roxann Leo, Tupper Hardman, Phil Richardson, Patsy King, Bo Baxter, Kourtney Shewmaker, Gaye Haralu and Kenny Wade.

1: Property Report: Kenny Wade reported the electrical wiring in Roxann's office and in the choir room to the air-conditioning units will have to be replaced to be compatible with the new heating and air-conditioning units, and he reported new breakers will have to be installed, also. He reported the concrete sidewalk has been replaced in front of the daycare center.

2: Financial report: Jim Ingram reported we are under budget and income is less than this time last year.

A: Approved transferring \$3500 from the capital fund to pay part of the security renovation for the church instead of paying it out of repairs and maintenance.

B: Phil Richardson will write a letter to Ritchie McGinnis thanking him for his services in renting the day care center. Ritchie McGinnis indicated there would be no charge for his services that he would consider his fee a donation to the church.

3: Church directory: Roxann reported the proofs of the new directory have been mailed to the church for review.

4: Daycare building update: no reported issues at the child daycare center.

5: New business:

A: green van: the committee approved trying to sell the van as soon as possible for it may be costing the church more in insurance to have the green van.

B: Phil Richardson reported that he would recommend to the executive board restructuring the number of church committees.

C: New Budget: Phil Richardson presented new budget for the year 2019, and it was tentatively approved by the AMT committee.

D: Cleanup day for the outside the church will be November 3, 2018.

The next AMT meeting is tentatively scheduled for Sunday, November 11 at 5 pm.

We plan to set up the Octoball ring for Halloween on October 31.

Mego Haralu and Bry Carkin reported on the bi-annual Disciples of Christ region meeting at Beargrass Christian Church in Louisville. Information was obtained about opportunities to help with the Appalachia project. We could go in with another Disciples church to help. Leslie Hardman will contact Lon Oliver about the Appalachia project.

Mego Haralu reported on the India mission trip. We will be getting tickets soon. About 13 people are planning to go. No other groups will be going at this time. A group in Australia will provide some support. Folajima from Nigeria is a visiting professor at Campbellsville. He said his church in Nigeria would help in the future with the children's school and orphanage. We will be able to get a chainsaw in India for Jack Coleman to use on the teak trees. The dates for the mission trip to India are December 27 to January 6.

It was decided at a previous Outreach ministry meeting to apply all of the budgeted Adult Mission line item and half of the budgeted Youth Mission line item to the mission trip to India. This will be used to support travel. No other material supply support will be requested from the board for this fiscal year. Money from the fundraising events will be applied to the India mission trip. The donations at the India themed luncheon after church on October 21 go to Elana and Smith Perkins to help recover from the house fire.

A special called Outreach ministry meeting will be held to discuss helping with the breakfast setup on Sunday mornings in December.
