Administrative Ministry Team met on June 19, 2018. Present were the following: Jim Ingram, Doug Greenburg, Roxann Leo, Tupper Hardman, Phil Richardson, Kourtney Shewmaker, Bo Baxter, Bry Carkin and Patsy King.

1: Property report: Roxann reported for Kenny Wade. Mulch will be added to the playground area of the church between the building and sidewalk. It was also reported the handicap door latch is not working properly and may cost \$1200.00 to repair.

Bids have been received to repair the sidewalk in front of the old comp care building now day care building from the church driveway to the corner of Greenville and Office Street. It was suggested to try to obtain other bids.

2: Financial report: Jim Ingram reported the total income is behind the budget approximately \$12,000. However, the giving to this point is approximately \$3000 more than last year at this time. The expenditures to this point are approximately \$12,000 behind budget.

3: The former comp care building now the daycare center has been leased. Work is in the process of converting the building to a daycare center. Issues the church needs to address are a water leak in the building, replacement of ceiling tiles and the light fixtures.

4: Springhill Day Camp report: Bry reported there were 74 registered to attend the day camp and 65 present on a daily average. The Methodist Church sponsored eight kids, And the Presbyterian church sponsored two. Each day a different church provided lunch for the adults working at the youth camp. Bry furnished the following breakdown of the cost of the camp and the number who attended on scholarships. There were a total of 40 scholarships. Several churches and other community groups made donations to help offset the cost of Springhill.

5: Security cameras: The security cameras to see who is entering the church have been ordered. Terry Doud is going to install these.

6: Church directory: as of this date 48 families have registered to have their picture taken for the church directory. The church has approximately 85 family units. Everyone is welcome and requested to register to have their picture made for the church directory. Anyone that hasn't registered contact Roxann.

7: New business: There will be no traditional vacation bible school this year.

A: It has been requested that Outreach Committee issue periodically written reports to the board and orally to the Congregation of who or what money is donated to by the church. Many members are not aware of who we donate to on behalf of the church.

The next AMT meeting date is Tuesday, July 17 at 5 p.m. in the church library.
