Dear HCC Members and Friends,

SpringHill Day Camp is coming to Harrodsburg this month. It is OFFICIAL!! Counselors and Day Camp Staff arrive on Sunday, June 10th and will be worshipping with us at the 10:30 a.m. worship service. They will settle in and set up camp the rest of Sunday and children will arrive Monday morning, June 11th, to begin camp! Camp will run from Monday, June 11-Friday, June 15th, from 9:00 a.m. until 4:00 p.m. It is so exciting to see this all come to fruition! And we pray that this will be a life-changing experience for many children in our community. Back in the fall it was just a dream. Step by step, Harrodsburg Christian Church leaders and other folks under Bry Carkin's leadership have met every challenge.

A proposal to the Mercer County School Board was approved for the Intermediate School to be the site for the camp this summer. The Christian Education Ministry Team and Outreach Ministry Team and Youth Group members worked together to hand out flyers at Kroger, in neighborhoods, at Anderson Dean Park and the Broadway Days Festival. Bry has been in ongoing contact with the Family Resource Ministry at the school and talking to everyone she can think of to help the children of Mercer County be able to experience this camp. The Mercer County Ministerial Association, the United Methodist Church, St. Philips Episcopal Church, Harrodsburg United Presbyterian Church, St. Barnabas Church of the Encourager, M.A.F.E.W., KIWANIS and other churches have given financial support, brought children to be signed up and are helping to provide special lunches for all the camp staff. We are so grateful for everyone's efforts!

The community meal on April 16 served 150 meals. The attendance for the past two months has been lower than the average.

Spring Hill Day Camp will be June 11 through 15. The goal is to have at least 60 young people attend. We will have more radio ads to publicize the Spring Hill Day Camp.

We will start collecting payments from members of the mission trip to India. The dates for the trip are currently planned for December 27 through January 11.

The Administrative Ministry Team met on May 15, 2018 with the following present: Doug Greenburg, Jim Ingram, Roxann Leo, Kenny Wade, Phil Richardson, Kourtney Shewmaker, Patsy King, Gaye Haralu, Bo Baxter and Bry Carkin.

1: Property report: Kenny Wade reported that he is checking on the air-conditioning units on the roof of the church.

2: Financial report: Jim Ingram reported church income is approximately 9% under budget. However, total income is actually more than at this time last year.

3: Springhill Day Camp report: Bry reported there are currently 34 registered at this time. The deadline to get the minimum number to attend is at the end of May. It appears there's going to be enough kids to sign up. Bry has done a good job in organizing and promoting the camp. She will need additional volunteers to help at the camp itself.

4: Comp care building report: Phil reported a proposed lease agreement with Kids for Christ Early Childhood Center, LLC, Heather Edwards, for one year to lease the comp care building for a daycare center. The lease will be for \$500 a month for the first four months and \$800 a month for the last eight months. There will also be a deposit of \$1000 required. This lease agreement is subject to the approval of the general board.

5: Security equipment for the church: Phil Richardson reported the church has made a deposit for the new security doors and video equipment .

6: Church directory: Roxann reported that a company has been selected for the church directory and that company is Re:Member. Pictures will be taken on July 10 and 11th of this year.

Next AMT meeting is set for June 19 at 5 p.m. and the executive board meeting shall be June 24. The AMT meeting date shall be July 17 at 5 p.m. and Executive board meeting will be July 22, 2018.
